



Violence in Your Workplace?

Does the potential for violence exist in your place of business?

Absolutely! I know this because you have people employed in your business and people have relationships with other people and sometimes they are a lot less than perfect.

According to the Department of Labor workplace violence is any act or threat of physical violence, harassment, intimidation, or other threatening disruptive behavior that occurs at the work site. It ranges from threats and verbal abuse to physical assaults and even homicide. It can affect and involve employees, clients, customers and visitors.

Data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics in 2011 revealed that violence and other injuries caused by persons or animals contributed to 17% of all occupational fatalities, with homicides contributing to 10% of the total.

I attended an "OSHA Compliance Seminar" recently and the presenter Jack Stasi stated that five years ago violence in the workplace was infrequently discussed and hardly a concern. Now it is the second highest cause of death for males working in the workplace and NUMBER 1 for WOMEN! Things have really changed in a very short period of time.

Why? Well, for one thing the estranged spouse, ex, partner or whatever may not know where their target is sleeping, but they usually know where they work. When the situation gets to this point it becomes extremely dangerous for you and all of your employees because statistics show what usually happens is they take out their target, anybody else who gets in the way and then themselves before leaving the premises.

Sometimes, not all of your employees are interested in playing well together, either. A situation or confrontation that may blow over without consequence 99 times out of 100 may turn out to be the straw that broke the camel's back today for one of them.

To protect workers, customers, visitors and anyone else who may come in contact with company personnel a zero-tolerance policy toward workplace violence should be established. This policy needs to written and communicated to all employees so that every one of them feels confident and comfortable knowing they have someone to turn to if they feel threatened or fear for their life. They need to know that management will take action to stop aggressive words or actions, bullying, and other destructive behavior.

Supervisors need to be trained to watch out for warning signs and indications of trouble and must believe that violence and threats are not just "part of the job". They

must be coached to really listen and be sensitive to comments made by subordinates.

Behaviors and attitudes that need to be monitored include:

- Chronic, hypersensitive complaints of injustice
- History of mental health problems
- Adverse reactions to authority and limits
- · Criminal history
- Frequent aggressive outbursts
- History of suicide attempts
- Alcohol misuse or other drug use
- Fascination with weapons and violence
- Holding grudges, inability to accept criticism, excuses, blaming others

As employers we have a responsibility to provide a safe work place for our employees. OSHA requires employers to provide their employees with working conditions that are free of known dangers. The same law prohibits employers from retaliating against employees for exercising their rights under the law (including the right to raise a health and safety concern or report an injury).
