At this time she is getting stronger every day and I can't help but think that all the love they have felt has done her some good for her recovery. We Need Each Other!



# DID YOU KNOW?



Did you know the NTPDA office receives numerous requests each month from people searching for parts for ag and industrial equipment? The requests come in the form of e-mails as well as phone calls. There are two points of reference given to the person in assisting with their search. One, they can select a state on the NTPDA homepage under Find a Member/ Dealer. When members in the
