



Business Models

I was relieved to see such positive response to the Conference and Trade Show in San Antonio. The board has been discussing for at least two years the need to mix it up a little and hopefully stimulate some enthusiasm and ultimately expand participation.

I know it is human nature to resist change because we all get so comfortable in our routines and it is just easier to keep doing things the way we like to or have been doing them. Quite often some life-changing event has to occur before we leave our comfort zone and make adjustments because we are forced to. Think back over your life or business career where you did something because you were forced to and when you look back you realize it was the best thing for you.

I read an article last month from the New York Times about the U.S. Postal Service warning lawmakers that it

will lose as much as \$18.2 billion a year by 2015 if Congress does not grant it leeway to eliminate Saturday delivery, slow down first-class mail by one day and raise the price of a postage stamp by as much as 5 cents. Wowdidn't the postage rate just increase two months ago?

Last December David Williams, vice president of network operations for USPS was promoting these lower level services as a means to become financially viable and acknowledged that they had lost 29 percent of their firstclass mail volume in the last decade. He also noted that current trends project another 47 percent drop in volume between now and 2020.

The U.S. Postal Service is an independent agency of our government. It does not receive tax money, but is subject to congressional control of large aspects of its operations (proposed changes in first-class mail delivery can be implemented without permission from Congress).

Postmaster General Patrick Donahoe has been suggesting reduced work days, slower delivery times, postage rate increases and reduced health care and other means of controlling labor costs.

After five years of operating in the red, Donahue stated, "We have a business model that is failing. You can't continue to run red ink and not make changes." Really, you think!

During the holidays one of our local postal employees complained that we were bringing too many parcels in one day and asked if we could cut back. This is what develops in a monopolistic situation where there is a lack of competition - higher rates, slower service and employees with attitude.

A free market is a form of natural selection- a business or any enterprise must evolve physically and mentally to survive.

According to Wikipedia, natural selection is the gradual, nonrandom process by which biological traits become either more or less common in a population as a function of differential reproduction of their bearers. It is a key mechanism of evolution; the process in nature by which, according to Darwin's theory of evolution, only the organisms best adapted to their environment tend to survive and

> transmit their genetic characteristics in increasing numbers to succeeding generations while those less adapted tend to be eliminated.

> In very simple terms natural selection has been referred to as survival of the fittest.

The U.S. Postal service has not adapted over time as the market they operate in has changed dramatically.

The significance to all of us is that this organization is the second largest employer in the United States and the challenge will be for Congress to make any changes affecting 653,000 employees in an election vear.
